Scott Hahn Reflects on the Fifth
Sunday of Easter.

John 15:1–8

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us that He is the true vine that God intended Israel to be—the source of divine life and wisdom for the nations.

In Baptism, each of us was joined to Him by the Holy Spirit. As a branch grows from a tree, our souls are to draw life from Him, nourished by His word and the Eucharist.

Paul in today's First Reading seeks to be grafted onto the visible expression of Christ the true vine—His Church. Once the chief persecutor of the Church, Paul encounters initial resistance and suspicion. But he is known by his fruits, by his powerful witness to the Lord working in his life (see Matthew 7:16–20).

We too are commanded today to bear good fruits as His disciples so that our lives give glory to God. Like Paul's life, our lives must bear witness to His goodness.

Jesus cautions us, however, that if we're bearing fruit, we can expect that God will "prune" us—as a gardener trims and cuts back a plant so that it will grow stronger and bear even more fruit. He is teaching us today how to look at our sufferings and trials with the eyes of faith. We need to see our struggles as pruning, by which we are being disciplined and trained so that we can grow in holiness and bear fruits of righteousness (see Hebrews 12:4–11).

We need to always remain rooted in Him, as today's Epistle tells us. We remain in Him by keeping His commandment of love, by pondering His words, letting them dwell richly in us (see Colossians 3:16), and by always seeking to do what pleases Him. In everything we must be guided by humility, remembering that apart from Him we can do nothing. As we sing in today's Psalm, we must fulfill our vows, turning to the Lord in worship, proclaiming his praises, until all families come to know His justice in their lives.

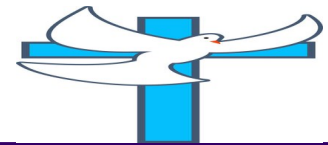

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús nos dice que Él es la vida verdadera que Dios quiso que fuera Israel: la fuente de vida divina y sabiduría para las naciones.

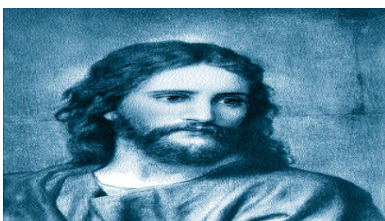
En el Bautismo, cada uno de nosotros fue unido a Él por el Espíritu Santo. Como una rama crece de un árbol, nuestras almas deben recibir vida de Él, alimentadas por Su palabra y la Eucaristía.

A nosotros también se nos manda hoy dar buenos frutos como sus discípulos para que nuestras vidas den gloria a Dios. Como la vida de Pablo, nuestras vidas deben dar testimonio de su bondad.

Jesús nos advierte, sin embargo, que si estamos dando fruto, podemos esperar que Dios nos “pode”, como un jardinero poda y poda una planta para que crezca más fuerte y dé aún más fruto. Él nos está enseñando hoy cómo mirar nuestros sufrimientos y pruebas con los ojos de la fe. Necesitamos ver nuestras luchas como poda, mediante la cual somos disciplinados y entrenados para que podamos crecer en santidad y dar frutos de justicia (Hebreos 12:4–11).

Necesitamos permanecer siempre arraigados en Él, como nos dice la epístola de hoy. Permanecemos en Él al guardar Su mandamiento del amor, al meditar en Sus palabras, al dejarlas habitar ricamente en nosotros (ver Colosenses 3:16) y al procurar siempre hacer lo que a Él le agrada. En todo debemos guiarnos por la humildad, recordando que separados de Él nada podemos hacer.

Mientras cantamos en el Salmo de hoy, debemos cumplir nuestros votos, dirigiéndonos al Señor en adoración y proclamando sus alabanzas, hasta que todas las familias lleguen a conocer Su justicia en sus vidas.
