Scott Hahn Reflects on the **23rd**

Isaiah 35:4-7
Psalm 146:7-10
James 2:1-5
Mark 7:31-37

The incident in today's Gospel is recorded only by Mark. The key line is what the crowd says at the end: "He has done all things well." In the Greek, this echoes the creation story, recalling that God saw all the things He had done and declared them good (see **Genesis 1:31**).

The crowd recognizes that Jesus is doing what the prophet had foretold. But Mark wants us to see something far greater—that, to use the words from today's First Reading: "Here is your God."

Notice how personal and physical the drama is in the Gospel. Our focus is drawn to a hand, a finger, ears, a tongue, spitting. In Jesus, Mark shows us, God has truly come in the flesh.

What He has done is to make all things new, a new creation (see **Revelation 21:1-5**). As Isaiah promised, He has made the living waters of Baptism flow in the desert of the world. He has set captives free from their sins, as we sing in today's Psalm. He has come that rich and poor might dine together in the Eucharistic feast, as James tells us in today's Epistle.

He has done for each of us what He did for that deaf mute. He has opened our ears to hear the Word of God and loosed our tongues that we might sing praises to Him.

Let us then give thanks to our glorious Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Let us say with Isaiah, "Here is our God, He comes to save us." Let us be rich in faith, that we might inherit the kingdom promised to those who love Him.

Scott Hahn reflexiona sobre el XXIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

El incidente del Evangelio de hoy lo registra únicamente Marcos. La frase clave es lo que dice la multitud al final: "Todo lo ha hecho bien". En griego, esto hace eco de la historia de la creación, recordando que Dios vio todas las cosas que había hecho y las declaró buenas (véase Génesis 1:31).

La multitud reconoce que Jesús está haciendo lo que el profeta había predicho. Pero Marcos quiere que veamos algo mucho mayor: "Aquí está vuestro Dios", para usar las palabras de la primera lectura de hoy.

Observe cuán personal y físico es el drama en el Evangelio. Nuestra atención se centra en una mano, un dedo, orejas, una lengua, saliva. En Jesús, nos muestra Marcos, Dios realmente ha venido en carne.

Lo que ha hecho es hacer nuevas todas las cosas, una nueva creación (véase Apocalipsis 21:1-5). Como prometió Isaías, ha hecho fluir las aguas vivas del Bautismo en el desierto del mundo. Él ha liberado a los cautivos de sus pecados, como cantamos en el Salmo de hoy. Él ha venido para que ricos y pobres puedan cenar juntos en el banquete eucarístico, como nos dice Santiago en la Epístola de hoy.

Él ha hecho por cada uno de nosotros lo que hizo por aquel sordomudo. Ha abierto nuestros oídos para escuchar la Palabra de Dios y ha desatado nuestras lenguas para que podamos cantarle alabanzas.

Demos gracias, pues, a nuestro glorioso Señor Jesucristo en la Eucaristía. Digamos con Isaías: "Aquí está nuestro Dios, que viene a salvarnos". Seamos ricos en la fe, para que podamos heredar el reino prometido a quienes lo aman.
