Scott Hahn Reflect on the 29th Sunday

“Live Truth, Live Catholic”

Readings:

Isaiah 53:10-11

Psalms 33:4-5,18-20,22

Hebrews 4:14-16

Mark 10:35-45

The sons of Zebedee hardly know what they're asking in today's Gospel. They are thinking in terms of how the Gentiles rule, of royal privileges and honors.

But the road to Christ's kingdom is by way of His Cross. To share in His glory, we must be willing to drink the cup that He drinks.

The cup is an Old Testament image for God's judgment. The wicked would be made to drink this cup in punishment for their sins (see **Psalm 75:9; Jeremiah 25:15, 28; Isaiah 51:17**). But Jesus has come to drink this cup on behalf of all humanity. He has come to be baptized—which means plunged or immersed—into the sufferings we all deserve for our sins (compare **Luke 12:50**).

In this He will fulfill the task of Isaiah's suffering servant, whom we read about in today's First Reading.

Like Isaiah's servant, the Son of Man will give His life as an offering for sin, as once Israel's priests offered sacrifices for the sins of the people (see **Leviticus 5:17-19**).

Jesus is the heavenly high priest of all humanity, as we hear in today's Epistle. Israel's high priests offered the blood of goats and calves in the temple sanctuary. But Jesus entered the heavenly sanctuary with His own blood (see **Hebrews 9:12**).

And by bearing our guilt and offering His life to do the will of God, Jesus ransomed “the many”—paying the price to redeem humanity from spiritual slavery to sin and death. He has delivered us from death, as we rejoice in today's Psalm.

We need to hold fast to our confession of faith, as today's Epistle exhorts us. We must look upon our trials and sufferings as our portion of the cup He promised to those who believe in Him (see **Colossians 1:24**).

We must remember that we have been baptized into His passion and death (see **Romans 6:3**).

In confidence, let us approach the altar today, the throne of grace, at which we drink the cup of His saving blood (see **Mark 14:23-24**).

Scott Hahn Reflexiona sobre el 29.º domingo

“Vive la verdad, vive como católico”

Lecturas:

Isaías 53:10-11
Salmo 33:4-5,18-20,22
Hebreos 4:14-16
Marcos 10:35-45

Los hijos de Zebedeo apenas saben lo que están pidiendo en el Evangelio de hoy. Están pensando en términos de cómo gobiernan los gentiles, de privilegios y honores reales.

Pero el camino al reino de Cristo es por medio de Su cruz. Para compartir Su gloria, debemos estar dispuestos a beber la copa que Él bebe.

La copa es una imagen del Antiguo Testamento para el juicio de Dios. Los malvados serían obligados a beber esta copa en castigo por sus pecados (ver Salmo 75:9; Jeremías 25:15, 28; Isaías 51:17). Pero Jesús ha venido a beber esta copa en nombre de toda la humanidad. Ha venido a ser bautizado, lo que significa sumergido o sumergido, en los sufrimientos que todos merecemos por nuestros pecados (comparar Lucas 12:50).

En esto Él cumplirá la tarea del siervo sufriente de Isaías, de quien leemos en la Primera Lectura de hoy.

Como el siervo de Isaías, el Hijo del Hombre dará Su vida como ofrenda por el pecado, como antaño los sacerdotes de Israel ofrecían sacrificios por los pecados del pueblo (ver Levítico 5:17-19).

Jesús es el sumo sacerdote celestial de toda la humanidad, como escuchamos en la Epístola de hoy. Los sumos sacerdotes de Israel ofrecían la sangre de machos cabríos y becerros en el santuario del templo. Pero Jesús entró en el santuario celestial con Su propia sangre (ver Hebreos 9:12).

Y al cargar con nuestra culpa y ofrecer su vida para hacer la voluntad de Dios, Jesús rescató a “muchos”, pagando el precio para redimir a la humanidad de la esclavitud espiritual del pecado y de la muerte.

Debemos recordar que hemos sido bautizados en su pasión y muerte (ver Romanos 6:3).

Con confianza, acerquémonos hoy al altar, trono de gracia, en el que bebemos la copa de su sangre salvadora (ver Marcos 14:23-24).
