Scott Hahn Reflects on the 8th Sunday In Ordinary Time

Sirach 27:4-7
Psalm 92:2-3, 13-16
1 Corinthians 15:54-58
Luke 6:39-45

In today's readings we hear Jesus speaking in Galilee as well as a Jewish sage named Sirach writing in Jerusalem more than a century earlier. The two of them touch upon a single truth: The words that come out of us make known the hidden thoughts within us. Speech reveals the secrets of the heart.

Sirach teaches that speaking is "the test of men" and their character. One who is upright will utter words that are truthful and encouraging to others. But one whose heart is cluttered with "refuse" will be exposed, since the "fruit" of his mouth speaks volumes about the "tree" that produces it. Sirach also compares the testing of our words to clay fired in a kiln—if properly prepared, a useful vessel emerges; but if the clay is not fully dried, it will break apart in the extreme heat.

In a similar way, Jesus insists that a person speaks "out of the abundance of the heart." He too compares our speech, whether good or bad, to what grows on a tree: "For no good tree bears bad fruit, nor again does a bad tree bear good fruit."

Both readings urge us to make wholesome speech a habit. After all, much about who we are is brought to light through what we say. But there's an additional step: The Lord is asking us to look inward, to examine our hearts and fill them with the "good treasure" that God desires.

Why do purity of heart and speech matter so much? Because, as Jesus declares elsewhere: "by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned" (Matthew 12:37). They matter because they help to decide our final judgment, and this is where the Second Reading comes in. Paul reminds us that God will destroy death forever, and if we are to share in this victory and live forever with the Lord, then we must take all steps necessary to give our hearts and lips to what is good.

Scott Hahn reflexiona sobre el VIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

En las lecturas de hoy escuchamos a Jesús hablando en Galilea, así como a un sabio judío llamado Sirácida escribiendo en Jerusalén más de un siglo antes. Los dos abordan una sola verdad: las palabras que salen de nosotros dan a conocer los pensamientos ocultos en nuestro interior. El habla revela los secretos del corazón.

El Sirácida enseña que hablar es “la prueba de los hombres” y de su carácter. El que es recto pronunciará palabras que sean veraces y alentadoras para los demás. Pero aquel cuyo corazón esté atiborrado de “basura” quedará expuesto, ya que el “fruto” de su boca dice mucho sobre el “árbol” que lo produce. El Sirácida también compara la prueba de nuestras palabras con la arcilla cocida en un horno: si se prepara adecuadamente, surge un recipiente útil; pero si la arcilla no está completamente seca, se romperá en el calor extremo.

De manera similar, Jesús insiste en que una persona habla “de la abundancia del corazón”. El también compara nuestro habla, ya sea buena o mala, con lo que crece en un árbol: “Porque ningún árbol bueno da frutos malos, ni tampoco un árbol malo da frutos buenos”.

Ambas lecturas nos instan a hacer del habla sana un hábito. Después de todo, mucho de quiénes somos sale a la luz a través de lo que decimos. Pero hay un paso adicional: el Señor nos pide que miremos hacia adentro, que examinemos nuestros corazones y los llenemos con el “buen tesoro” que Dios desea.

¿Por qué importa tanto la pureza de corazón y de habla? Porque, como declara Jesús en otro lugar: “por tus palabras serás justificado, y por tus palabras serás condenado” (Mateo 12:37). Son importantes porque ayudan a decidir nuestro juicio final, y aquí es donde entra en juego la Segunda Lectura. Pablo nos recuerda que Dios destruirá la muerte para siempre, y si hemos de compartir esta victoria y vivir para siempre con el Señor, entonces debemos tomar todas las medidas necesarias para entregar nuestro corazón y nuestros labios a lo que es bueno.
