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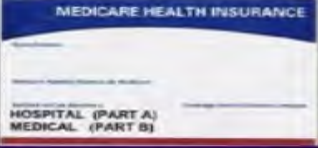

Holy Week is the most important week in Catholicism.
This week of great reverence and reflection spans the final eight days of Jesus' life — from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday. It is astounding how much wisdom, insight and inspiration are available to us during this one week. Here is just a sample of what happens during Holy Week:

- Palm Sunday, Jesus triumphantly enters Jerusalem
- Monday of Holy Week, Jesus clears out the temple with a whip
- Tuesday of Holy Week, Jesus is anointed with oil at Bethany and preaches on the Mount of Olives
- Spy Wednesday, Jesus is betrayed by Judas
- Holy Thursday, Jesus celebrates the Last Supper, prays in the Garden of Gethsemane, and is arrested
- Good Friday, Jesus is sentenced to death, scourged, beaten, crucified, and dies on the Cross
- Holy Saturday, Jesus is buried in the tomb and descends into hell
- Easter Sunday, Jesus rises from the dead

Father Carlos Ortega invites each of the parishioners to join him to begin a spiritual pilgrimage using the book "33 Days to Eucharistic Glory". Instead of 33 consecutive days, the preparation for the consecration will take place over 33 weeks (during which we will meet one evening per week) Dare to discover what God can do in your life in 33 days! APRIL 13, 2025 PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

Lc 19, 28-40 /Is 50, 4-7/Responsorial Psalm 21, 8-9. 17-18. 19-20. 23-24/ 2)/Flp 2, 6-11 / Lc 22, 14—23, 56 or 23, 1-49

The reading for the procession on Palm Sunday Year C reminds us to recognize Jesus as our king and savior.

In the passage, Jesus enters Jerusalem, greeted with joy by the people. They shout, “Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord!” and lay their cloaks and palm branches on the ground before him.

This event symbolizes Jesus’ authority and leadership. The people of Jerusalem saw Jesus as their king and welcomed him. We are also called to recognize his authority and welcome him into our lives. Following Jesus requires faith and obedience.

We need to submit our will to his and trust in his plan. Just as the people laid down their cloaks and palm branches, we must be willing to surrender everything to him.

Recognizing Jesus as our king also means acknowledging his power to save us. As our savior, he offers salvation and eternal life.

Trusting in him and following his teachings brings us closer to his love and guidance. As we reflect on this reading, let’s recommit ourselves to accepting Jesus as our king and savior. Let us lay down our own “cloaks and palm branches,” symbolizing our willingness to follow him. Finally, may we remember the power of Jesus’ love to guide and change our lives. By doing so, we can be part of his eternal kingdom and experience the fullness of life he offers.

ABRIL 13, 2025 DOMINGO DE RAMOS DE LA PASIÓN DE CRISTO

Lucas 19:28-40/Is 50:4-7/Salmo 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24 (2a)/Phil 2:6-11 /Lucas 23:1-49

La lectura de la procesión del Domingo de Ramos del Año C nos recuerda que debemos reconocer a Jesús como nuestro rey y salvador. En el pasaje, Jesús entra en Jerusalén, recibido con alegría por el pueblo. Gritan: "¡Bendito el rey que viene en el nombre del Señor!" y depositan sus mantos y palmas en el suelo ante él.

Este evento simboliza la autoridad y el liderazgo de Jesús. El pueblo de Jerusalén vio a Jesús como su rey y lo recibió. Nosotros también estamos llamados a reconocer su autoridad y acogerlo en nuestras vidas. Seguir a Jesús requiere fe y obediencia. Necesitamos someter nuestra voluntad a la suya y confiar en su plan. Así como el pueblo dejó sus mantos y palmas, debemos estar dispuestos a entregarlo todo a él. Reconocer a Jesús como nuestro rey también significa reconocer su poder para salvarnos.

Como nuestro salvador, nos ofrece salvación y vida eterna. Confiar en él y seguir sus enseñanzas nos acerca a su amor y guía.

Al reflexionar sobre esta lectura, renovemos nuestro compromiso de aceptar a Jesús como nuestro rey y salvador.

Dejemos a un lado nuestros mantos y palmas, simbolizando nuestra disposición a seguirlo.

Finalmente, recordemos el poder del amor de Jesús para guiar y transformar nuestras vidas. Al hacerlo, podemos ser parte de su reino eterno y experimentar la plenitud de vida que él nos ofrece.
