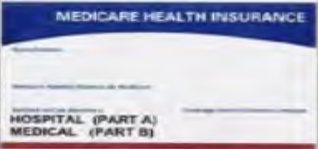
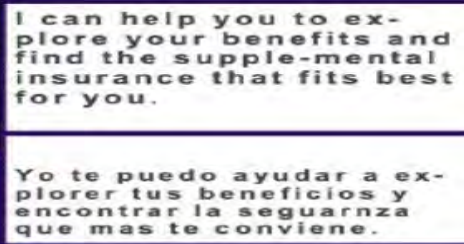

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER MAY 11, 2025 Acts 13:14, 43-52; Rv 7:9, 14b-17; Jn 10:27-30

In the Old Testament, the image of the Shepherd is often applied to God as well as to the leaders of the people. The book of Exodus represents Yahweh several times as a Shepherd. The prophets Isaiah and Ezekiel compare Yahweh’s ongoing care of His people to care a shepherd exercises for his flock. Ezekiel represents God as a loving Shepherd who searches diligently for the lost sheep. Psalm 23 is David’s famous picture of God as The Good Shepherd: “The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.” In the New Testament: Jesus introduces himself as the Good Shepherd of his flock and makes three claims in today’s Gospel.

Let us become good shepherds and good sheep, good leaders and good followers. (1) Let us become good shepherds: Everyone who is entrusted with the care of others is a shepherd. Hence, pastors, parents, teachers, doctors, nurses, government officials, etc. are all shepherds. We become good shepherds by loving those entrusted to us, praying for them, spending our time and talents for their welfare, and guarding them from physical and spiritual dangers. (2) Let us be good sheep in the fold of Jesus, the Good Shepherd: Our local parish is our sheepfold, and our pastors are our shepherds. Hence, as the good sheep of the parish, parishioners are expected to a) hear and follow the voice of their shepherds through their homilies, Bible classes, counseling, and advice; b) receive the spiritual food their pastors provide by regular participation in the Holy Mass, by frequenting the Sacraments, and by attending prayer services, renewal programs, and missions; c) cooperate with their pastors by giving them positive suggestions for the welfare of the parish, by encouraging them in their duties, by lovingly offering them constructive criticism when they are found misbehaving or failing in their duties, by praying for them always, forgiving them at need; and d) by cooperating in the activities of the various councils, ministries, and parish associations. (3) Let us pray for vocations to priestly and religious life so that we may have more good shepherds to lead, feed, and protect the Catholic community.

CUARTO DOMINGO DE PASCUA MAYO 11, 2025 HC.13:14, 43-52; AP. 7:9, 14b-17; JN. 10: 27-30
En el Antiguo Testamento, la imagen del Pastor se aplica a menudo tanto a Dios como a los líderes del pueblo. El libro del Éxodo representa a Yahvé varias veces como Pastor. Los profetas Isaías y Ezequiel comparan el cuidado constante de Yahvé por su pueblo con el cuidado que un pastor ejerce por su rebaño. Ezequiel representa a Dios como un Pastor amoroso que busca diligentemente a la oveja perdida. El Salmo 23 es la famosa imagen que David presenta de Dios como el Buen Pastor: «El Señor es mi pastor; nada me faltará». En el Nuevo Testamento, Jesús se presenta como el Buen Pastor de su rebaño y hace tres afirmaciones en el Evangelio de hoy.Seamos buenos pastores y buenas ovejas, buenos líderes y buenos seguidores. Seamos buenos pastores: Todo aquel a quien se le confía el cuidado de otros es un pastor. Por lo tanto, los pastores, padres, maestros, médicos, enfermeras, funcionarios del gobierno, etc., son todos pastores. Nos convertimos en buenos pastores al amar a quienes se nos confían, orar por ellos, dedicar nuestro tiempo y talentos a su bienestar y protegerlos de peligros físicos y espirituales. Seamos buenas ovejas en el rebaño de Jesús, el Buen Pastor: Nuestra parroquia local es nuestro rebaño y nuestros pastores son nuestros pastores. Por lo tanto, como buenas ovejas de la parroquia, se espera que los feligreses escuchen y sigan la voz de sus pastores a través de sus homilías, clases de Biblia, consejería y consejo; reciban el alimento espiritual que sus pastores proporcionan participando regularmente en la Santa Misa, frecuentando los Sacramentos y asistiendo a los servicios de oración, programas de renovación y misiones. cooperar con sus párrocos dándoles sugerencias positivas para el bienestar de la parroquia, alentándolos en sus deberes, orando siempre por ellos, perdonados cuando sea necesario; y cooperando en las actividades de los diversos consejos, ministerios y asociaciones parroquiales.
