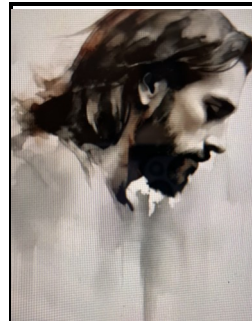

¡Las virtudes, explicadas!

El Papa Pablo VI, en *Ecclesiam Suam*, consideró que la «lealtad, la perseverancia y el sacrificio de sí mismo» son los rasgos distintivos de un cristiano en un mundo moderno que abraza cada vez más el relativismo. «El seguidor de Cristo no es pusilánime ni cobarde, sino leal y fuerte», escribió. La virtud de la lealtad está estrechamente vinculada a la virtud de la obediencia, mediante la cual nos sometemos libremente a la autoridad legítima. Como católicos, estamos llamados a ser leales a nuestros obispos, a la Sagrada Escritura y a la Tradición, a la autoridad doctrinal de la Iglesia (el Magisterio) y al modo de vida cristiano. La lealtad se distingue de la admiración hacia una persona o institución, e incluso del respeto. La admiración y el respeto pueden ganarse legítimamente y perderse también legítimamente. La lealtad virtuosa no se desvía de su objeto, y emana de quien la ofrece.

Virtues, Explained!

Pope Paul VI, in Ecclesia Suam, considered “loyalty, perseverance and self-sacrifice” to be the distinguishing marks of a Christian in a modern world that increasingly embraces relativism. “The follower of Christ is not pliant and cowardly, but loyal and strong,” he wrote. The virtue of loyalty is closely linked to the virtue of obedience, wherein we freely submit ourselves to rightful authority. As Catholics, we are called to be loyal to our bishops, to Scripture and Tradition, to the teaching authority of the Church (the Magisterium), and to the Christian way of life. Loyalty is distinct from admiration for a person or institution, and even from respect. Admiration and respect can be rightfully earned and rightfully lost. Virtuous loyalty does not swerve from its object, and it flows forth from the one who gives it.

Con la Ascensión, sucedió algo nuevo y hermoso: Jesús llevó nuestra humanidad, nuestra carne, al cielo —es la primera vez—; es decir, la llevó a Dios. Esa humanidad que Él había asumido en la tierra no se quedó aquí. Jesús resucitado no era un espíritu, no. Tenía su cuerpo humano, carne y huesos, todo.

Él estará allí, en Dios, para siempre. Podríamos decir que, desde el día de la Ascensión, Dios mismo «cambió»: desde entonces, ya no es solo espíritu, sino que tal es su amor por nosotros que lleva nuestra propia carne en sí mismo, ¡nuestra humanidad! Queda así indicado el lugar que nos espera; ese es nuestro destino. (...) ¿Qué hace Jesús en el cielo? Él está allí por nosotros, ante el Padre, mostrándole continuamente nuestra humanidad; mostrándole sus llagas. Me gusta pensar que Jesús reza así ante el Padre: mostrándole sus llagas. «Esto es lo que sufrí por la humanidad: ¡haz algo!». Él le muestra el precio de la redención y el Padre se conmueve. Esto es algo en lo que me gusta pensar. Así reza Jesús. No nos dejó solos. De hecho, antes de ascender, nos dijo —como relata el Evangelio de hoy—: «Yo estoy con ustedes todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo» (Mt 28, 20). With the Ascension, something new and beautiful happened: Jesus brought our humanity, our flesh, into heaven — this is the first time — that is, he brought it in God. That humanity that he had assumed on earth did not remain here. The risen Jesus was not a spirit, no. He had his human body, flesh and bones, everything.

He will be there in God forever. We could say that from the day of the Ascension on, God himself “changed” — from then on, he is not only spirit, but such is his love for us that he bears our own flesh in himself, our humanity! The place awaiting us is thus indicated; that is our destiny. (...) What does Jesus do in heaven? He is there for us before the Father, continually showing our humanity to him — showing him his wounds. I like to think that Jesus, prays like this in front of the Father — showing him his wounds. “This is what I suffered for humanity: Do something!” He shows him the price of redemption and the Father is moved. This is something I like to think about. This is how Jesus prays. He did not leave us alone. In fact, before ascending, he told us, as the Gospel says today, “I am with you always, to the close of the age” (Mt 28:20). (Pope Francis, Regina caeli, 21 May 2023)
